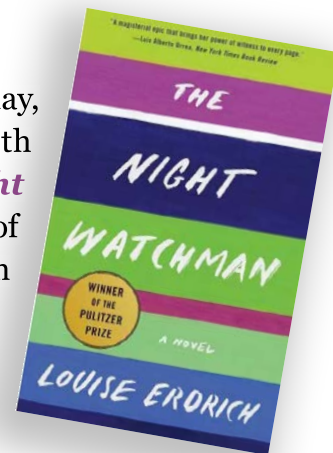


Tucker Book Group is Thursday, June 20th
