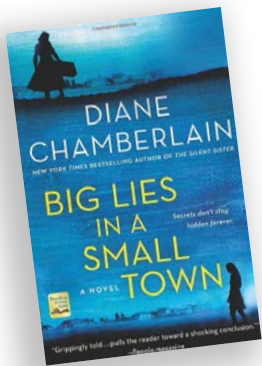
SHREDDER TRUCK

You may be surprised at some of the items you need to shred that you probably aren't: junk mail, which may include personal data; pictures and old id's – old pictures can be used by thieves to steal your identity; travel itineraries; boarding passes; shipping labels; Post-It notes, on which may have jotted down personal information; old bank statements; canceled checks. When in doubt, have it shredded! The financial and reputational risk of having an identity stolen is too great not to put in the little bit of extra effort it takes to shred a document. And the peace of mind is priceless.
