





An Open Letter to My Church **Family**

To my faith family here in Tucker, it is with both deep gratitude and sadness that I write this letter to you. By the time this letter is printed, Easter Sunday will have been my final Sunday on staff here at FBC Tucker. Sparing you your time and the printer its ink, I will

be brief in my writing to you. It was announced March 24th that my family and I would be leaving Georgia to move back to Kentucky to be closer to my mother. The goal of this article is not to restate and expound the "why" of our leaving, but to instead give a charge to you.

I desire nothing more for you than that you "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Pet. 3:18). Growth in our spiritual lives is often like it is in our physical: pain is involved. It can be difficult. However, growth will never come without obedience to what God has called you to. I wish to encourage you to be obedient to the clear and direct commands of your Lord Jesus Christ found in the authoritative, God-breathed Scriptures.

Jesus said in several places, but perhaps most clearly in John 14, that obedience to God's word is in direct correlation with love for Him. Love for God will produce obedience. Obedience to God's commands prove to the world around us that we are His people. Likewise, disobedience to God and yet calling Him 'Lord' is simply unfathomable (Lk. 6:46). It

> is clear: love and obedience are wed together in a union that cannot be broken. We ultimately love God, John tells us, because God first loved us (1 John 4:19).



Had it not been for that, our hearts are not only uninclined to love God, but incapable (Eph. 2:1-5). We love our Lord because of His great salvation He has given to us. It is out of that love that we begin to seek to glorify Him

with our day-to-day living. In so doing, when difficult decisions come to us, they become easier to make when we know that the God who called us to the decision has our good and His glory in mind.

The decision to leave behind all we have here in Georgia, including a church that I believe to be on the precipice of something great, was made ultimately because above all else, Lindsey and I want to be obedient to our Lord Jesus. In my life, the biblical and present call is to the care of my widowed mother, whose faith, wisdom, and humility has been a teacher to me all my life. The honoring of parents, care of widowed parents, and service to family are high calls found from cover to cover in the Bible. This is God's design for His people, and as Paul expounds on this topic in 1 Timothy 5, is actually "putting your religion into practice."

So, you see, I am consumed and bound by holy writ, I cannot do differently. This is what I hope for each of you: that you recognize and cherish the Scriptures as holy, authoritative, and good, and that you joyfully obey. We cannot know what God is telling us unless we are in His word, for there we find His mind and heart. Judge every thought and action of your own by the Scriptures; in so doing, you will find yourself doing more work pleasing to God, and less of what displeases and shames Him.

Space does not allow me time to list the many ways this church has blessed my family in the short time we have been here. I have been even more blessed to have gotten to know you all and be of service to you. Thank you for investing in my family and me, for loving my kids, and allowing me the opportunity to teach and serve you these few years. As Paul said to his beloved church in Phillipi, so I say to you: "Make my joy complete by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind" (Philippians 2:2).

May the grace of God abound in your lives.
